



TDI Monthly Update

August 2014

Temporary Disability Insurance

Initial Claims – A total of 3,611 initial applications for Temporary Insurance Benefits (TDI) were filed during the month of August. Approximately 86 percent of the applications were approved and 14 percent were denied.

Payments – During the period 30,492 payments totaling \$13.5 million were issued. TDI payments averaged \$442 per week.

Temporary Caregiver Insurance

TCI claims – Of the 3,611 initial TDI applications filed during the month of August, 468 (13.0%) were Temporary Caregiver Insurance benefits (TCI). A total of 355 (75.9%) were approved and 113 (24.1%) were denied.

Type of Claim– Less than one-quarter (18.0%) of the TCI claims approved were for care of a family member and more than three-quarters (82.0%) were for bonding with a child.

Reason for Claim – The majority (80.0%) of TCI Claims approved were for bonding with a new born, followed by care of a spouse (9.0%) and both care of a parent and care of child at (4.5%).

TCI Payments – During the month of August; 1,097 TCI payments totaling over \$550 thousand were issued. TCI payments averaged \$502 per week.

To Date – 3,200 TCI initial claims have been filed accounting for 10.3 percent of the 30,974 TDI applications filed. There have been 7,802 TCI payments issued to date totaling \$3,927,900.
