


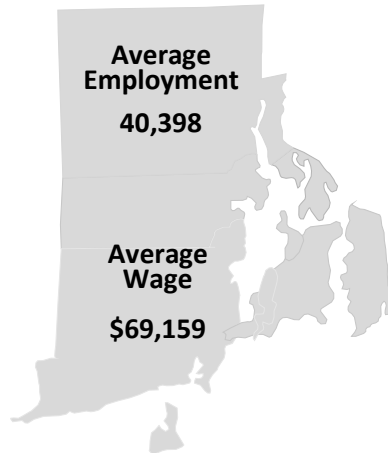

2023 Total Manufacturing

Durable Goods Manufacturing

Hard goods or goods that don't wear out quickly and last for a long period.

- * Represented **63.8** percent or **25,777** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$72,472
- * Transportation Equipment manufacturing represented 28.2 percent or 7,260 of the durable goods workforce.




Nondurable Goods Manufacturing

Soft goods or goods that have a short life cycle.

- * Represented **36.2** percent or **14,621** of the total manufacturing workforce
- * Average wage: \$63,320
- * Food manufacturing represented 28.1 percent or 4,102 of the nondurable goods workforce.
