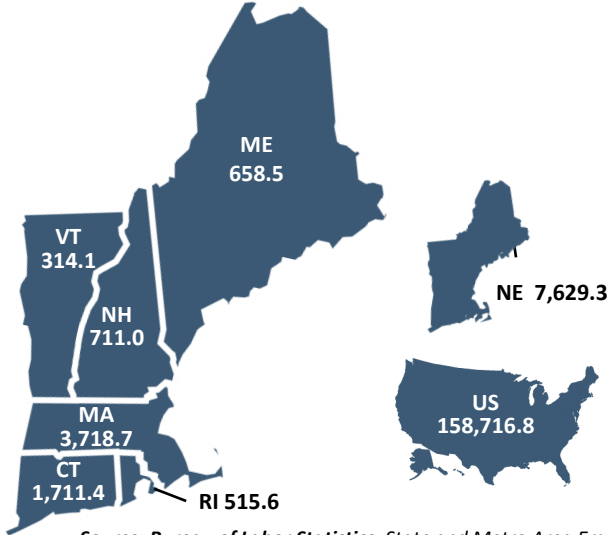


Total Number of Jobs (in thousands)

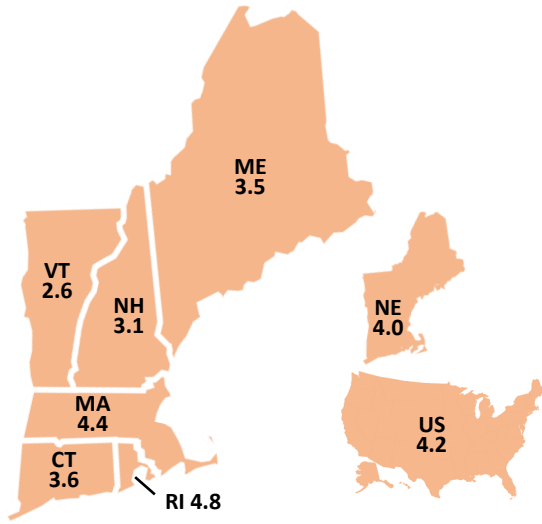

Unemployment Rate



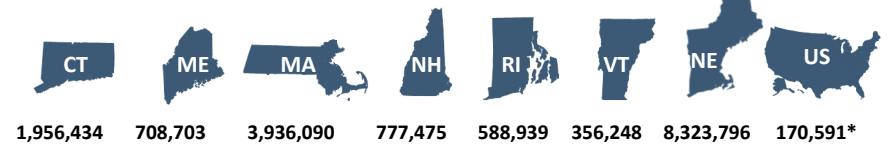
